[Isaiah 46:9] Remember the former things, those of long ago; I am God, and there is no other; I am God, and there is none like me.

[Isaiah 43:19] See, I am doing a new thing! Now it springs up; do you not perceive it? I am making a way in the wilderness and streams in the wasteland.

[Psalm 107:20] He sent out his word and healed them; he rescued them from the grave.

[Proverbs 18:21] Death and life are in the power of the tongue: and they that love it shall eat the fruit thereof.

[Hebrews 4:12] For the word of God is alive and active. Sharper than any double-edged sword, it penetrates even to dividing soul and spirit, joints and marrow; it judges the thoughts and attitudes of the heart.

[Hebrews 11:3] By faith we understand that the universe was formed at God's command, so that what is seen was not made out of what was visible.

[2 Corinthians 4:18] So we fix our eyes not on what is seen, but on what is unseen, since what is seen is temporary, but what is unseen is eternal.

[2 Corinthians 5:7] For we live by faith, not by sight.

[Revelation 3:21] To the one who is victorious, I will give the right to sit with me on my throne, just as I was victorious and sat down with my Father on his throne.

[Proverbs 4:23] Above all else, guard your heart, for everything you do flows from it.

[Proverbs 21:23] Those who guard their mouths and their tongues keep themselves from calamity.

[Luke 6:45] A good man brings good things out of the good stored up in his heart, and an evil man brings evil things out of the evil stored up in his heart. For the mouth speaks what the heart is full of.

[1 Peter 2:24] “He himself bore our sins” in his body on the cross, so that we might die to sins and live for righteousness; “by his wounds you have been healed.”

[Isaiah 26:3] You will keep in perfect peace those whose minds are steadfast, because they trust in you.

[Romans 8:1-2 AMPC] Therefore, [there is] now no condemnation (no adjudging guilty of wrong) for those who are in Christ Jesus, who live [and] walk not after the dictates of the flesh, but after the dictates of the Spirit. For the law of the Spirit of life [which is] in Christ Jesus [the law of our new being] has freed me from the law of sin and of death.

[Revelation 2:7] Whoever has ears, let them hear what the Spirit says to the churches. To the one who is victorious, I will give the right to eat from the tree of life, which is in the paradise of God.

[Revelation 3:21] To the one who is victorious, I will give the right to sit with me on my throne, just as I was victorious and sat down with my Father on his throne.

[Revelation 12:11] They triumphed over him by the blood of the Lamb and by the word of their testimony; they did not love their lives so much as to shrink from death.

[Matthew 5:14-16] “You are the light of the world. A town built on a hill cannot be hidden. Neither do people light a lamp and put it under a bowl. Instead they put it on its stand, and it gives light to everyone in the house. In the same way, let your light shine before others, that they may see your good deeds and glorify your Father in heaven.
